We write to update you on this term's Young Lawyer Programme, where students will be immersed in a series of interactive role plays with leading barristers and solicitors.

We are excited to announce that our young lawyers will hear video evidence from witnesses in a mock murder trial and partake in live cross-examination. The trial will be conducted by two criminal barristers, and students will contribute to cross-examination through strategic pauses. They will also play the role of the jury.

Other activities will include:

- Challenging opponents in a high-profile litigation case
- Advising a client on a sensitive human rights issue
- Public speaking coaching by expert barristers

In addition, students will gain:

- Dedicated coaching on every aspect of **breaking into a top legal job**, including advice on A-level, degree, extra-curricular, and university choices;
- A chance to meet and **network with some highly-accomplished lawyers** who can become excellent career mentors.

Lawyers on the programme will include:

- Former human rights legal adviser to the current Prime Minister
- Head of graduate recruitment at a top US law firm
- Barristers specialising in serious criminal cases
- Senior corporate lawyer at a 'Magic Circle' law firm
- Family lawyer working on high-profile divorce cases
