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## School Trips & Excursions

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School trips and excursions are part of our school community life. It integrates and supports the attainment of the eight key competences configured for lifelong learning, personal fulfillment and active citizenship. Every year the school organises from one-day school excursions to multi-day school trips, either for entire school levels (e.g. S2, S4) or for groups (e.g. S3L2FRA). Each trip carries a unique educational, didactic, and social value. Some may focus on academic projects such as the Climate Academy, others focus on subjects such as history, geography, arts or languages; while even others on students well-being.

Excursions organised by teachers promote learning outside classrooms and are linked to the syllabus. They are carried out during two fixed *outing weeks* in the school year, although some excursions for expositions and theatres may be spread during the year. Trips and excursions for the school year 2026-2027 are the following:

Besides basic motor skills, it encourages lifelong fitness, health, pupils' social integration, tolerance, fair play and cooperation within different linguistic sections and cultural backgrounds. **S2 Residential Trip:** from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2026 to [Vayamundo-Hauffalize](#)

Sessions aim to nurture children, and develop social skills, confidence, leadership, and problem solving. The program includes sport, educational, and outdoor pursuits. Evening activities are also organised to enrich the experience. The club offers excellent facilities and experienced instructors in a safe and secure environment tailored for school groups. **The approx. price of 460 € is a 3 days/2 nights package all inclusive, organised by *Move & Study*. The school finance department bills it in two installments; one at the start of the school year, and the other approximately 30 days before departure.**

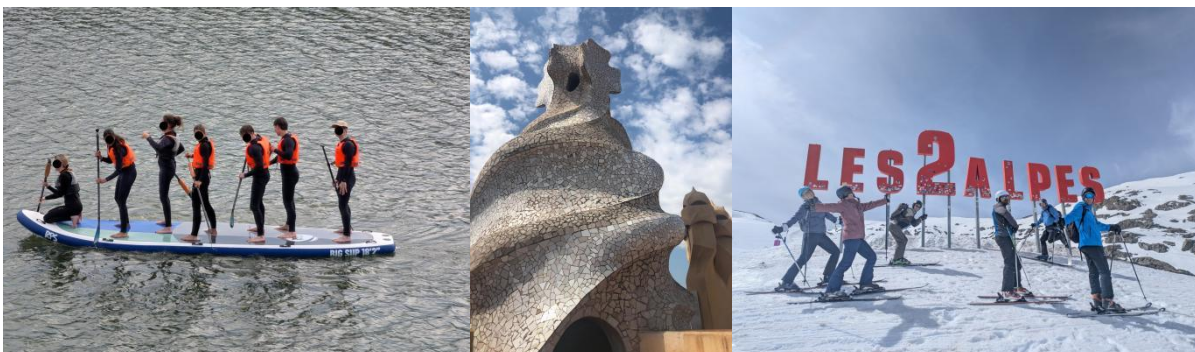
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**S5 Bio Educational Field Outings:** between April 29 to May 05, 2027

These outings bridges the gap between classroom theory and reality by allowing students to observe complex concepts like evolution and genetics directly in nature. By collecting hands-on data and analysing local ecosystems, students develop crucial scientific methodologies, critical thinking, and a deep sense of environmental situation. This immersive experience not only strengthens collaborative teamwork but also provides vital academic clarity, helping students make an informed choice about pursuing advanced 4-period Biology in the high-stakes S6 and S7 European Baccalaureate cycle. **The finance department bills it in two installments; one around 60 days and the other 30 days before departure, if price goes over a 100 euros (usually for a multi-day trip). For less than 100 euros (one day outing), the teacher or the class parent representative collects the money to cover the expenses.**

## **S6 Abroad Trips:** From April 28 to May 5, 2027

A turning point experience in the European Schools' curriculum, bridging classroom learning with real-world discovery right before the final Baccalaureate year. This journey is a powerful opportunity to build personal independence, forge lifelong friendships across different language sections, and enjoy a rewarding mental reset. Young adults develop vital life skills like budgeting, problem-solving, and ecological awareness. More than just a trip, it is a unique, unforgettable opportunity to actively experience European solidarity and global citizenship in action. **Every year, several destinations are proposed to choose from (Spain, Italy, France, UK...) and prices may therefore vary from 950 EUR to 1250 EUR. The finance department bills it in two installments; one around 60 days and the other 30 days before departure.**
