

Calculators – Rules in EEB2

This document outlines the implementation of digital tools utilized at EEB2, with a specific focus on calculators.

Classwork and Exams:

- In levels S1 to S3, students are given the option to choose from three scientific calculators: the TI-30X Pro MathPrint, the TI-36X Pro, and the Casio FX-991 EX Classwiz. The selection is made by the student's science teachers upon entering S1, and they retain the chosen calculator until S3.
- For levels S4 to S6, students must use a graphic calculator with specific functionalities. The school recommends the TI-84 Plus CE-T Python Edition. It is the only calculator that teachers have and teach how to use. If a student already possesses another calculator, its use has to be validated by the maths teacher and will be self-taught.
- <u>In S7</u>,
 - for the academic year 2023-24, students are given a choice among three scientific calculators: the TI-30X Pro MathPrint, the TI-36X Pro, and the Casio FX-991 EX Classwiz. The Baccalaureate exams must be undertaken using one of these three calculators.
 - Starting from the academic year 2024-25 and onwards, students will continue using the graphic calculators they acquired in previous years.

During exams in S5, S6, and S7, when employing the TI-84 graphic calculator, it must be set to exam mode.
